Generic Name	Trade Name	Commonly Prescribed For...
Acetaminophen	Tylenol	Pain
Albuterol	Proventil	Asthma, bronchitis, other breathing disorder
Alendronate	Fosamax	Osteoporosis
Allopurinol	Zyloprim	Lowers uric acid; treats gout and some kidney stones
Alprazolam	Xanax	Benzodiazepine: Anxiety
Amlodipine	Norvasc	Hypertension; chest pain (angina)
Amoxicillin	Amoxil, Augmentin	Antibiotic
Amphetamine & Dextroamphetamine	Adderall	ADHD
Aripiprazole	Abilify	Schizophrenia/ bi-polar disorder
Atenolol	Tenormin	Hypertension; angina
Atomoxetine	Strattera	ADHD
Atorvastatin	Lipitor	Lowers cholesterol and triglyceride levels
Azithromycin	Z-Pak, Zithromax	Antibiotic
Bupropion	Wellbutrin	Depression; also aids in smoking cessation
Carvedilol	Coreg	Hypertension; CHF
Celecoxib	Celebrex	NSAID; common for rheumatoid arthritis
Ciprofloxacin	Cipro	Antibiotic
Citalopram	Celexa	Depression
Clonazepam	Klonopin	Panic attacks/ anxiety/ seizures
Clonidine	Plavix	Clot prevention
Clotrimazole	Lotrisone	Antifungal
Cyclobenzaprine	Flexeril	Muscle relaxant
Dextromethylphenidate	Focalin	ADHD

Note:

- Medications ending with **-lol** are beta-blockers, and are prescribed for hypertension, CHF, and management of cardiac arrhythmias. They're sometimes used to treat migraines.
- Medications ending with **-statin** are used to reduce cholesterol and triglyceride levels.
